Bringing Peter Rabbit's adventures to life, Executive Chef Seumas Smith and Executive Pastry Chef Yong Ming Choong have created a menu that blends nature-inspired ingredients with culinary artistry.

The savoury selection reimagines classic high tea elements with country garden flair. *Mr. McGregor's Garden Sandwich* pairs beef brisket and miso in a soft seed sandwich, with garden accents reminiscent of Mr. McGregor's allotment. *Fisherman's Haven*, inspired by Mr. Jeremy Fisher's watery escapades, combines Petrosino smoked salmon with cucumber, horseradish, and crème cru. *Mrs. Tiggy-Winkle's Picnic Pie* offers a coronation smoked chicken vol-au-vent, while *The Forbidden Orchard Tartlet* melds foie gras and apple, celebrating Mr. McGregor's irresistibly shiny red apples. Additional highlights include *The Garden Croissant*, with tomato, melon, and honey ricotta, a tribute to the garden's vibrant bounty. *The Woodland Hideaway*, a wild mushroom mousse with parmesan, cep, and sherry vinegar, is reminiscent of Squirrel Nutkin's secret hideaways.

The dessert selection illustrates the playful charm of *The World of Peter Rabbit*™. *Flopsy's Berry Basket* is a waffle basket brimming with blueberries and edible flowers, while *Peter's Garden Treat*, a carrot cinnamon tea cake, nods to his mischievous garden escapades. *Benjamin's Orchard Tart* balances crisp apple with zesty yuzu, and *The Peter Rabbit Macaron* is adorned with an illustration of Peter and blends cassis and vanilla.

Other highlights include *Mr. McGregor's Toadstool*, a vanilla raspberry cheesecake, and *Peter's Garden Pot*, a visually captivating creation featuring chocolate gelato, citrus confit, and cocoa soil, designed to resemble a miniature garden. Entirely edible, it is intricately adorned with edible flowers, including the vibrant purple Dianthus grown on the hotel's own rooftop Aquaponics Farm.

An English Garden high tea is not complete without scones. Guests will enjoy freshly baked raisin and vanilla scones, served with homemade jam and Devonshire clotted cream. Themed beverages include *Mischief in the Garden*, a sweet and earthy cocktail with vodka, carrot juice, orange juice, honey ginger syrup, lemon juice, and soda, and *Flopsy's Blossom Fizz*, a floral mocktail blending peach purée, coconut syrup, rose water, blue pea water, and rosemary.

It was first published by Frederick Warne & Co. (today an imprint of Penguin Random House) in 1902 and the story has never been out of print since, selling in excess of 46 million copies worldwide.
